1. Overview & Commitment

Advanced Security Connections, LLC (“ADVSEC,” “we,” “our,” “us”) is committed to protecting the privacy, confidentiality, and data sovereignty of our clients, website visitors, and operational partners (“you,” “your”).

We do not run advertising trackers, analytics cookies, or third-party marketing pixels on this domain. This Privacy Policy describes exactly what data we collect, how it's processed, and which third parties are involved — including in our interactive diagnostic tools.

2. Domain Perimeter Governance

ADVSEC operates an automated front-door governance model at the web perimeter layer:

- **Perimeter Licensing:** Our domain directives, crawling parameters, and usage terms for automated agents, web scrapers, and Answer Engine Optimization (AEO) systems are declared via the **Really Simple Licensing (RSL)** standard at <https://adv-sec-conn.com/license.rsl>
- **Autonomous Agent Access:** Automated agents and artificial intelligence platforms ingesting assets on our domain are bound by our live RSL directives, geographical fencing controls, and cryptographic attribution requirements.

3. Secure Communications & Zero-CRM Architecture

We route official communications through providers chosen for their privacy practices:

- **Encrypted Email Routing:** Official email communications are processed using zero-access encrypted infrastructure hosted via Proton Mail.
- **Encrypted Messaging (Signal):** For direct messaging and secure video calls, ADVSEC uses the Signal app's end-to-end encrypted protocol.
- **Contact Form:** Submissions through our Contact page are processed by Netlify Forms (with Cloudflare providing network-level routing/security), which receive your submitted information solely to deliver it to our internal inbox. Neither service is authorized to use this data for any other purpose.

4. Information We Collect

- **Voluntary Information:** Name, organizational role, email address, and message content you provide when contacting us or engaging our advisory services.
- **Technical & Operational Logs:** Basic server access metrics (e.g., IP addresses, request timestamps) collected for Web Application Firewall (WAF) protection, rate-limiting, and defense against automated/malicious traffic. These logs are not used for tracking, profiling, or marketing.

5. Our Interactive Diagnostic Tools

Our PDF Metadata Forensic Portal and related applications process files you choose to submit for testing:

- **What we read:** Only the document's structural metadata (Layer 2/3) — never the rendered visual page content.
- **Retention:** Submitted files and their metadata are processed transiently for the duration of your session and are not stored in a database or retained afterward.
- **AI Sub-processor:** To generate the interactive diagnostic chat, extracted metadata is sent to Google's Gemini API for analysis. This is the one point in our pipeline where data leaves our direct infrastructure to a named third-party processor, and it happens only when you actively use the diagnostic chat feature.

6. Data Security

We employ physical, technical, and cryptographic controls to safeguard information against unauthorized access, disclosure, or alteration. Publicly distributed technical white papers and spec sheets issued by ADVSEC are forensically hardened under our Flagposting Framework to establish document provenance and tamper-evident authenticity.

No electronic transmission over the public internet can be guaranteed 100% secure. We minimize third-party exposure to the practical extent our tools and services allow, and this policy names every third party currently involved.

7. Sharing and Third-Party Disclosures

- **No Sale of Data:** ADVSEC does not sell, lease, or trade personal information or client communications to data brokers or advertisers.
- **Named Sub-processors:** Proton Mail (email), Signal (messaging), Google Gemini API (AI diagnostic analysis in our forensic tools), Netlify (contact form processing), Cloudflare (network routing/security), GitHub (site source hosting — no personal data). We do not use any sub-processor beyond what's named in this policy without updating it first.
- **Legal & Regulatory Requests:** Information will only be disclosed if compelled by valid, lawful orders from competent court authorities within our jurisdiction (Georgia, USA).

8. Your Choices & Access Rights

- **Direct Communication Control:** You may request updates, corrections, or deletion of your contact information by reaching us through the channels in Section 3.
- **Cookie Management:** We do not set tracking or advertising cookies. Basic session/security tokens may be used at the web perimeter to distinguish legitimate traffic from automated attacks; browsers can be configured to restrict these.

ADVSEC reserves the right to update this policy as our tools, sub-processors, or infrastructure change. The effective date at the top of this document reflects the authoritative current version. Material changes — such as adding a new sub-processor — will be reflected here before they take effect.
